CITY OF EAST ORANGE NEW BULKY TRASH GUIDELINES

The City of East Orange has recently implemented new guidelines on bulky trash.

A limit of 3 bulky items is all that the City of East Orange will collect on your bulky trash day. Bulky items consist of furniture, cabinets, mattresses, box springs, screens, rolls of carpet (must be cut to 4 feet wide), bathroom fixtures, empty paint cans and similar items. If you have more than this 3 item limit, you CANNOT put it at the curb.

Scrap wood and branches (cut to 4 foot lengths and tied in no more than 3 bundles, that can be lifted by one person), is also bulky trash.

Lawn and garden debris will be picked up on your bulk garbage day. We do not collect dirt, stones, concrete, bricks, tree stumps or logs.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

.....

Q. Is there a limit to the number of bulky items I can place at curb?

A. Yes, you can only place 3 items at the curb.

Q. Do I need to call for bulky trash to be picked up?

A. No, you do not need to call. Items will be picked up on your scheduled bulk day. Keep bulky trash separate from your garbage.

Q. When is the earliest I can put out bulky trash?

A. You can place bulky trash out after 5pm on the night before your scheduled pick up day.
