



Construction of upgrades and improvements to White Oak Ridge Pumping Station, at a cost of \$2,103,469.25, were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project involves the installation of a generator and all associated equipment to provide backup power to the White Oak Ridge Pumping Station, improving the effectiveness of the operation of the Pumping Station which provides water service for residents and businesses in the City of East Orange.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
