ORDINANCE NO. 3 OF 2021**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 60, ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 60-47
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF EAST ORANGE ENTITLED
“HOLIDAYS AND LEAVES OF ABSENCE”**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EAST ORANGE:

SECTION 1. (amended section only)

That § 60-47 of the Code of the City of East Orange be amended and supplemented to add to the existing list of official holidays therein the observance of June 19th of each year “Juneteenth Day” as an official holiday.

§ 60-47. Holidays

A. Except as hereinafter provided, the following are the official holidays with pay to be observed by this City:

New Year's Day
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
Lincoln's Birthday
Washington's Birthday
Good Friday
Memorial Day
Juneteenth Day
Independence Day
Labor Day
Columbus Day
General Election Day
Veterans Day
Thanksgiving Day
Day After Thanksgiving
Christmas Day

SECTION 2

Each section of this ordinance is an independent section, and the holding of any section or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any other sections or parts thereof.

SECTION 3

All ordinances and parts of ordinances and conflicts that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 4

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage.
